Monday 24th September**



2017 - 2018 has proven to be another successful year for the PTA at Mytham Primary School. My role as Chair for the FOM has been a busy challenging and equally enjoyable, but I find it very rewarding. When I look back with an overall sense of satisfaction and pride for what we managed to achieve. Whilst levels of support have varied, we are very lucky to have enthusiastic PTA members, parents and teachers who support the work that we do and therefore benefit every child at Mytham Primary School.

We have raised a total £12,517.83 in 2017/8, we have had many fundraising events such as the New Monster Mash discos, Mytham's Got Talent, Christmas Fayre, Easter bingo and the Summer Fayre. Money raised over the past year continues to be put to effective use such as to purchase leavers gifts, the Christmas Parties, transport for educational trips, outdoor water-proof for KS1 and the list goes on and we are saving up for our next main project. So at the end of year we are reporting that we made a profit of £5,814.60

The FOM works so hard to benefit the education of every single child in the school. We are so fortunate to have a strong, dedicated team including Michelle Henderson (Vice-chair) and Vanessa Marsden (Treasurer) who has helped me over the past year. A special thank you to my parents and family for their support with events and purchasing items, also thank you to the many other parents and members of the school who willingly spend their time and money supporting the above events.

It is also important for me to acknowledge the support of a band of parents who whilst not members of the FOM can be called upon to help set up and run events - you know who you are and your support is very much appreciated! Thank you.

I'm grateful too for the on-going support and guidance of our head teacher, Angela Bogle. We understand that the balance between school priorities, teacher schedules and FOM requests can be difficult to achieve and feel that we are all working to create a strong FOM team. Finally, the role of Chairperson can be demanding and time consuming, but I do hope to build further upon the success of the past year. I hope to welcome new members to FOM and also expand our list of willing volunteers and helpers at events. We are always grateful for feedback from parents about events and would always welcome any suggestions for different ways in which we could raise funds. Without the dedicated and tireless support of the FOM, and support at events, we would not be able to achieve all that we do - our motivation continues to be 'for the children'.
