A warm welcome to GREENFOLD As you will be aware we have moved the nursery over to the school from the Little Lever centre. The nursery is where the Y1 classroom and Community Room used to be!

We had a fantastic turn out for the Y6 workshop last week. We had about 85% attendance ! Around 60% for Y3/4 last night and far less for Y2...only 25% attendance ? It's a shame when staff put in so much effort and stay late for the meetings to have low attendance. We sent reminders. We are happy to hear feedback about reasons so that we can address in future. We have them at 6.00pm so working parents can attend.

All is going well and I want to thank parents for their patience while the new arrangements around the new fences in playgrounds have settled down. We are sure you appreciate that the new fences have needed to be installed to ensure we can comply with safeguarding while nursery parents are coming and going at lunchtime. It is a shame that we have needed to use part of the KS1 playground for the nursery playground however we have plans to address outside space and are trying to make alternative arrangements.

Why have we moved nursery over to school?

Governors and I agreed with the Local Authority, that Greenfold Special School could use the nursery space at the centre for a Special Needs Unit for around 12 Reception ages pupils with disabilities (Age 4 to 5). The space has been remodelled over the summer and after a busy couple of weeks we have welcomed the children this week. Mytham school is not responsible for the education and care of these pupils, we are simply sharing the building. We are looking forward to working in partnership with them.

Parking around Herbert Street

Parking around the back of school is now really tight. Greenfold have minibuses transporting children and I need to please urge parents to consider this when parking. Mytham parents should not park within the centre **AT ALL**—even for coffee mornings—as the spaces are all needed for Greenfold and Kids Planet staff. I apologise that this will make the situation with parking even more challenging . Whatever you do please do not park on Lindley Street as it is a **PRIVATE ROAD** owned by residents and not for public access.
