It is our intent at Mytham Primary School to inspire our pupils with a love of languages and other cultures through a high-quality French curriculum. We aim to foster children's curiosity and build their understanding of cultures beyond their own.

Our curriculum is designed to gradually build our pupils' understanding and awareness, from early exposure to the language through songs and rhymes, to a strong emphasis on listening and speaking in Lower Key Stage Two to developing reading and writing skills in Upper Key Stage Two. Our curriculum is designed around six repeated units of work based on real-life scenarios creating purposeful opportunities to learn.

Our lessons focus on developing children's confidence and ability to enjoy listening to spoken French and responding, both orally and in written form as they progress. Learning opportunities focus on real-life situations making the learning purposeful. We aim to ignite a passion for languages which our pupils can explore in more depth as they move to high school on the next step of their journey.

Weekly lessons are sequenced to consider prior learning alongside the acquisition of new skills and vocabulary.

When they leave Mytham, we intend that our pupils are curious, creative and confident language learners who have a range of transferrable skills with which to acquire their further learning.
