### Key Knowledge

#### What should I already know

That our school is in the town of Little Lever and that our weather is different than other parts of the world.

Where the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans are on a world map.

Where the UK and Brazil are on a world map and name the continents they are located in.

The seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK and in the Amazon Rainforest.

There are geographical similarities and differences (human and physical geography) between Little Lever and the Caboclo dwellings in the Amazon Rainforest.

The local people who live along the Amazon river (Caboclo) have different lives compared to ours because of their location in the world.

How to devise a simple map and use/construct a key.

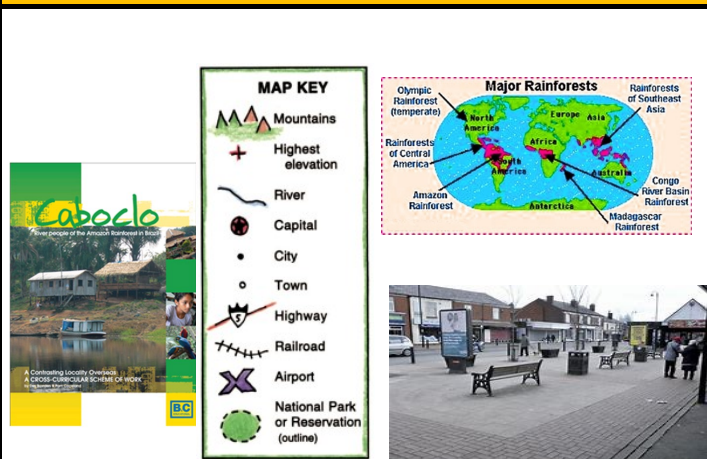
#### Possible experiences/Outcomes

| <b>Physical features</b> -a feature on the earth's surface that has been formed by nature eg trees, oceans |                                                                                      |
| forest                                                                                                     | Large area dominated by trees                                                        |
| ocean                                                                                                      | A huge body of salt water                                                            |
| continent                                                                                                  | A large land mass joined together, containing many countries                         |
| season                                                                                                     | Divisions of the year, defined by changes in the weather                             |
| weather                                                                                                    | State of the atmosphere with respect to things such as heat/cold, wetness/dryness    |
| vegetation                                                                                                 | Plant life of a region                                                               |
| river                                                                                                      | A flowing, moving stream of water                                                    |
